Attorney David Royston presented. He explained that the location has been a law office for a number of years. The current signs were previously approved. Because of a merger with a law firm in Middletown, the name of the law office has now changed to the Arch Law Group. As a result, they need a new sign and will be replacing the current signs. They plan to use a decal over the existing painted sign and replace the hanging sign with a new one. T. Rupp asked if the chain on the hanging sign is stainless steel to prevent rusting. Mr. Royston believes it will be stainless steel but will pass on the recommendation. A. Laferriere asked if any lighting will be used, and Mr. Royston responded that there will not be any lighting.
