COVID-19 Public Health Emergency – TOWN STATUS – RED

The following Community Update is being provided to you from the
Town of Old Saybrook Emergency Operations Center.

The intent of this document is to provide a summary of preparedness, response,
Emergency Protective Measures and other government activities.

Public Safety & Community Information

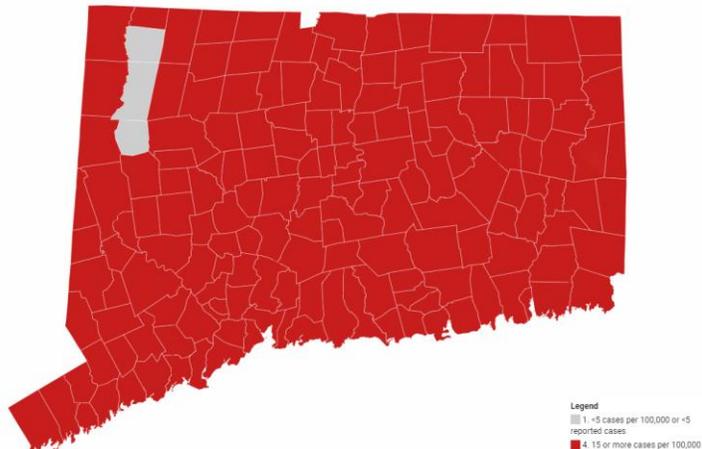
- The Nation, State, and Town remain under Declared States of Emergency.
- The Town's Emergency Operations Center (EOC) remains operational.
- Old Saybrook belongs to the Connecticut River Area Health District (CRAHD).
- This includes the Towns of Chester, Clinton, Deep River, Haddam, and Old Saybrook.
- These are the total reported Positive Residential Cases, since March, according to CRAHD:

-	Chester	-	69 Confirmed Cases
-	Clinton	-	444 Confirmed Cases
-	Deep River	-	152 Confirmed Cases
-	Haddam	-	223 Confirmed Cases
-	Old Saybrook	-	317 Confirmed Cases

These numbers DO NOT include any Positive Cases at Convalescent Facilities.

- **Old Saybrook is experiencing a VERY high COVID-19 positivity rate. We are in the RED!**
- **We NEED YOUR help to STOP Community Spread of COVID-19. This is serious!**
- Contact Tracing shows that transmission is occurring at social gatherings.

Average Daily Rate of COVID-19 Cases Among Persons Living in Community Settings per 100,000 Population By Town



This map shows the average daily rate of new cases of COVID-19 by town during the past two weeks. Only cases among persons living in community settings are included in this map; the map does not include cases among people who reside in nursing home, assisted living, or correctional facilities.

Community COVID 19 Testing

- Testing is still VERY Important!
- From September 30, 2020 to January 10, 2021 12,583 people have been tested in OS!
- 918 people tested positive during that time – that’s a 7.3% positivity rate at this testing site.
- FREE COVID-19 Testing continues each day at Saybrook Point – 9 AM – 4 PM.
- No appointments / No fees! Please get tested!
- The COVID-19 PCR Test is the most reliable test and takes 2-3 days for results to be available.
- The average wait time at the Old Saybrook Testing Site is 2 hours – so please arrive early!

COVID 19 Vaccination Efforts

- We are SOOOOO happy to report that we have begun vaccination efforts!
- This IS the light at the end of the tunnel!
- The Drive Through Vaccination Clinic in Old Saybrook is run by CRAHD, OSPD, & OS Emergency Management and is located at the OS Middle School.
- To date, Old Saybrook’s COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic has vaccinated 1,300 people.
- Vaccinations, in accordance with Public Health Guidelines, were provided to Medical Professionals, First Responders, those living in elderly congregate settings, and educators.
- Vaccinations continue this week **by appointment only**.
- DO NOT come to the middle school to get vaccinated UNLESS you have an appointment.
- Phase 1b will offer the vaccine to over 1.2 million people.
- Currently the State is receiving 44,000 doses of vaccine per week. (We don’t like this math)
- Therefor Phase 1b will be “rolled out” in segments.
- In addition to those 75 and older Phase 1b includes:
Healthcare Personnel not vaccinated in 1a, First responders not vaccinated in 1a, Education, Manufacturing, Grocery/Restaurant/Food Service & Essential Retail, Agriculture & Farm Workers, Delivery Professionals, Public Transit, Social & Governmental Services, Drinking Water/Waste Water & Solid Waste Workers, and Inspectors that work in the locations above.
- Right now the State’s focus is on those who are 75 and older – soon it will be 65 and older.
- At the Old Saybrook Vaccination Clinic, we are averaging ten vaccinations every fifteen minutes.
- As we receive additional vaccine we will offer appointments through the VAMS System.

I'm 75 or Older - How Do I Get Vaccinated?

- There are several ways to schedule an appointment to get vaccinated.
- Here are the ways....

Through VAMS / Through a Health Care Provider

VAMS

- VAMS stands for **Vaccine Administration Management System**.
- This is the government's preferred method for you to schedule an appointment.
- To use this method, you **MUST** create a VAMS Account to get vaccinated.
- Click this link to create a VAMS Account, then follow the instructions provided.

- A unique email account for each person registering is required to use the VAMS System.
- VAMS appointments are only being provided to those 75 and older.
- When searching for an appointment on VAMS try searching Old Saybrook – We might have open appointments! (Again these appointments are for those 75 or older at this time)
- We do have a limited amount of VAMS appointment left in Old Saybrook for this coming week. Keep checking!

SOME VAMS TIPS!

- **Registering through VAMS is a multi-step process.**
- There will be up to a 12 hour delay between account verification emails.
- We have found some of our elderly friends finding the process frustrating and difficult.
- Offer to help that special 75+ person in your life out! Do this for them!
- If you are registering for a loved one or friend – create a unique email address for them. You will need your email address when it is time for you to register for a vaccine in the future!
- If you are 75 or older and cannot make an appointment using a computer you may do so by phone. Please call 877-918-2224. This option is available Monday – Friday from 8AM-4PM.
