COVID 19 Community UPDATE #63 – May 27, 2020

The following Community Update is being provided to you from the

Town of Old Saybrook Emergency Operations Center.

The intent of this document is to provide a summary of preparedness, response and other government activities.

Public Safety & Community Information

- The Nation, State, and Town remain under Declared States of Emergency.
- The Town's Emergency Operations Center (EOC) remains operational.
- There was one (1) new CONFIRMED case of COVID-19 in Old Saybrook since Monday.
- Old Saybrook belongs to the Connecticut River Area Health District (CRAHD).
- This includes the Towns of Chester, Clinton, Deep River, Haddam, and Old Saybrook.
- There were new CONFIRMED cases of COVID-19 in our Health District since Monday.
- These are the current reported Positive Cases according to CRAHD:

-	Chester	-	46 Confirmed Cases	10 Deaths
-	Clinton	-	58 Confirmed Cases	3 Deaths
-	Deep River	-	12 Confirmed Cases	2 Deaths

- Haddam 31 Confirmed Cases 1 Death
 - Old Saybrook 33 Confirmed Cases
- Apple Rehab has sadly lost five (5) patients to COVID-19. Our condolences to the Families.

■ To give perspective there are 83 residents at Apple. There are 35 COVID-19 Positive patients in the facility. 15 staff members have also tested positive.

■ Town Officials have been in contact with the State Department of Public Health regarding the matter at Apple Rehab.

■ The State inspected the facility today. The facility falls under the jurisdiction of the State Department of Public Health.

Based on the information that is being shared with us, we DO NOT feel that the matter at Apple Rehab will cause a Community Spread Problem.

■ Gladeview Healthcare is voluntarily testing all residents. (None have symptoms!)

• We will provide those test results when we receive them.

■ The Town stands at the ready to support Apple Rehab and/or Gladeview Healthcare should they need any assistance.

- Businesses that requested thermometers from the State began receiving them today.
- Wear a mask to prevent Community Spread. We are counting on you!
- Still need face masks? Not able to make it last week? No problem!
- Simply stop by the Police Department, provide proof of residency, and get your masks!

Public Health

- These plans are now being vetted by Public Health and Public Safety Officials.

■ Discussions are being held and plans are being formulated to allow students to retrieve belongings from the school. More to come in the next few weeks.

■ The District is planning for Summer School and the Fall Opening of Schools as best as possible.

■ Federal and State Authorities have not yet issued final guidance on "What schools will look like in the fall" or how we must operate.

• Over the last two days the District has provided 998 Students with breakfast and lunch.
