18-016 "Bradley" Application to Conduct a Regulated Activity

Demolish existing house and construct a 4,507 s.f. house with 2,595 s.f. garage. 14 Dogwood Lane (Map 7/Lot 41

Applicant: Richard & Marcia Bradley, owner Agent: Joseph P. Wren, P.E.

18-017 "Pelczar" Application to Conduct a Regulated Activity

Remove existing deck and four sheds and add a stair tower and 8 x 4 ft. deck. 140 Ingham Hill Road (Map 48/Lot 1) Applicant: Pamela L. Pelczar, owner

The Commission revisited the presentation at the previous meeting and its discussion about the proposal to rearrange deck location and multiple shed removals to accommodate the stair tower, remaining shed and patio.

Stipulated Judgment in Settlement of the Superior Court case

Christina M Costa, et al v. Legacy 4 Him, et al 810 Middlesex Turnpike, (Map 63/Lot 8)

Plaintiff: Inland Wetlands & Watercourses Commission Agent: Alan P. Curto, Esq.

The Commission reviewed Plan A and Plan B proposed for the property at 810 Middlesex Turnpike with Ms. Nelson, and invited Attorney Cassella to address concerns about possible fluid leakage from vehicles in the gravel lot proposed for those waiting to be serviced, as well as the direction of surface runoff from rain or melting snow. The Commission discussed the viability of several different stormwater management practices to prevent potential pollution, including a swale between the proposed split rail fence and the wetland.

MOTION to recommend approval of the Stipulated Judgment in the matter of Christina Costa ZEO et al v. Legacy 4 Him et al., substantially in the form discussed this evening, with the addition of a contour swale to either Plan A or Plan B that would generally follow the 44 ft. elevation as a reasonable measure that would mitigate the impact of stormwater runoff between the rear parking area and the wetland, and subject to the approval of the other Plaintiffs; MADE by C. Wehrly; SECONDED by R. Esty; VOTING IN FAVOR: C. Wehrly, C. Savage, R. Esty, P. Kay; OPPOSED: None; ABSTAINING: None; APPROVED: 4-0-0.
