I. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman C. Heffernan called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

III. NEW BUSINESS

23-003 "Town of Old Saybrook Transfer Station" Application to Conduct a Regulated Activity

Removal of storage trailers, construction of gravel parking area and construction of 242 s.f. open sided structure.

499 Middlesex Tpke (Map 57/Lot 31)

Applicant/Owner: Town of Old Saybrook Agent: Geoffrey L. Jacobson, P.E.

ACTION: Receive application, review for completeness, accept application and determine if regulated activities are significant.

Bill Claffey presented. He briefly explained the project at the Transfer Station, which includes the removal of storage trailers, the addition of second lane to enter, the addition of parking spots, and the addition of an open structure to serve as the facility's take-it/leave-it area. He explained that the changes will keep the public away from the trash areas.

J. Kulowiec asked about whether there is any intent to change the food scraps area. Mr. Claffey explained that the Transfer Station is using a new system through Blue Earth for food scraps. C. Savage asked about the area of gravel and Mr. Claffey stated that everything will be gravel except for the handicap parking.

L. Gray made a correction to "and application" on page 3 to state "an application" in the following sentence: "C. Savage stated that the Commission needs specific, conclusive support to turn down and application and he does not feel such support exists here."

- **B.** Committee, Representative & Staff Reports P. DeLisa stated that the Conservation Commission did not meet for lack of a quorum and that it is seeking members. L. Wacker reported that the application for Whole Foods, 1654 Boston Post Road, is in the packets. This application was accepted in the Land Use Office and is being received at the current meeting. A pre-application meeting took place. She further reported that the application was missing a few items and that while those items are prepared, and given that this is a significant action, she sent out requests for Ordinance 71 fee estimates from consultants. The Whole Foods application should be on the April agenda if the materials are received from the applicant in time. Additionally, she is planning on scheduling a site walk with the applicant once the public hearing opens.
- C. Correspondence & Announcements L. Wacker announced that the Public Notice Registry was updated to include new applications on the IWWC webpage. Due to this change, any interested person can sign up to receive email alerts for new applications when they are posted to the IWWC web page. Additionally, L. Wacker mentioned as a follow-up to the wetlands educational workshop that any IWWC Commission member that relies on their own particular expertise during meetings should submit a resume to be added to the file.
