A. 17-012 "Pasta Vita" Application to Conduct a Regulated Activity

Application to remedy violation of two building additions and to construct a dumpster enclosure and relocate existing dumpsters at 225 Elm Street, Map 38/Lot 3.

Applicant/Owner: RLC Properties, LLC Agent: Joe Wren, P.E.

ACTION: Accept application, Review for completeness, determine if regulated activities are significant and determine if Ordinance 71 fees are required.

Chairman Heffernan did not feel the commission could accept the application from Pasta Vita at this time. He would like Pasta Vita to submit a remediation plan to be examined at the next meeting.

Joe Wren, the agent for Pasta Vita asked to make an informational presentation. The commission agreed. He explained that two sheds were removed and pavement taken up and crushed stone put down. Two additions have been added to the existing building. He also said that they were proposing recyclable dumpsters be enclosed and relocate the existing dumpsters. Chairman Heffernan asked the members for their opinions or questions. There were some concerns regarding the roof of one of the additions. They did not want water coming off onto the ground. Mr. Wren assured them that the building in question had sufficient gutters. Chairman Heffernan thanked Mr. Wren for his information.
