Request for Proposals ("RFP") Reconstruction of four stairs at North Cove Road Clothesline Marine Facility Old Saybrook, Connecticut

1. Summary and Background

The Town of Old Saybrook Connecticut, Harbor Management Commission ("OSHMC") is currently accepting proposals for reconstruction of 4 stairs at 125 North Cove Road. The stairs provide public access to the town's clothesline small boat mooring facility.

This Request for Proposal (RFP) is intended to solicit proposals from various qualified organizations, conduct a fair and extensive evaluation based on criteria listed herein, and select the qualified organization who provides the highest quality/ value at the lowest cost and is consistent with the Scope of Work and requirements contained within.

The Old Saybrook Harbor Management Commission is an elected commission charged with overseeing the harbor and waterfront facilities of the Town of Old Saybrook, Connecticut. Any decisions and awards made by the Town of Old Saybrook Harbor Management Commission are subject to the further approval of the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Old Saybrook.

2. Proposal Guidelines

This RFP represents the requirements for an open and competitive process. Proposals will be accepted until 4:30pm EST July 14th, 2021. Any proposals received after this date and time will not be considered for this project. All proposals must be signed by an official agent or representative of the company submitting the proposal.

If the organization submitting a proposal must procure or subcontract any work to meet the requirements contained herein, this must be clearly stated in the proposal.

Reasonable purchase Order terms and conditions will be negotiated upon selection of the winning bidder for this RFP. All contractual terms and conditions will be subject to review by Old Saybrook Board of Selectmen who have the final authority to approve this Purchase Order.

3. Project Scope

The base scope of this RFP is as follows:

The intent of the project is to completely demolish, remove and dispose of the existing stairs and provide new stairs with top and bottom concrete landings in accordance with the approved design documents provided. Through November 1st, 2021, the work will be phased such that only two stairs remain open for public access at all times. Demolition and construction will start

on Stair A and C first while Stair B and D must remain in service and un-obstructed until A and C are complete and accepted for use. After November1st, 2021, all 4 stairs may be taken out of service. The OSHMC has obtained regulatory permit documents and building permit for the stairs. All new work must be performed above the State of CT Coastal Jurisdiction Line (CJL) which is indicated on the site plan and has been staked out in the field. No use or storage of construction equipment shall be allowed below the CJL. Prior to demolition, the silt fence barriers shall be installed at the base of the stairs under construction as shown the design drawings.

5. Request for Proposal and Project Timeline

Prior to the due date of this RFP the Old Saybrook Harbor Management Commission will make reasonable efforts to answer any questions prospective bidders may have. Question must be submitted in writing by July 7th, 2021. All proposals in response to this RFP are due no later than 4:30pm EST July 14th, 2021.

All work should be complete no later than December 15st, 2021.

The selection decision for the winning bidder will be made no later than July 24, 2021 at which time a notice to proceed will be issued. The proposal should specify the date the bidder proposes to begin work and when all work will be complete.

6. Project Price and Payments

The scope of the project is shown in the following drawings which are contained in Exhibit A:

- Existing Conditions Survey dated January 20,2021
- GNCB Drawings SKA, SKB, SKC, SKD & SKE dated 13 March 2021
- Indigo Stair Insert Drawing SI-1 Sheet 1 & 2

All proposals must include the bidder's cost for each stair separately and with concrete work separately identified.

Payments will be made upon completion and delivery of concrete work on each stair and the completion of the balance of the work on each stair.. Invoices must be submitted on the first Monday of each month so that they can be approved at the regular Harbor Management Commission Meeting held on the second Monday of each month. A 10% retainage will be held on all payments until final acceptance of the project. Lien and claim waivers will be required for all payments.

7. Miscellaneous Requirements.

With your proposal, provide a description and duration of the product warranty..

All changes to the work must be submitted in writing by the Contractor and agreed by the Harbor Commission prior to being implemented.

8. Bidder Qualifications

Bidders should provide a description of experience with similar projects, including concrete work including references. If a major work item is to be sub-contracted out, provide experience and references for the proposed sub-contractor

9. Proposal Evaluation Criteria

The Old Saybrook Harbor Management Commission will evaluate all proposals based on the following criteria. The OSHMC will be evaluating the proposals to determine which proposed designs achieve the goals of the OSHMC at the best value. To ensure consideration for this Request for Proposal, your proposal should be complete and include all of the following criteria:


- Cost and Value: Bidders will be evaluated and overall cost.






CONSTRUCTION NOTES:

- 1. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONTACT "CALL BEFORE YOU DIG" AT 800-922-4455 TO MARK OUT ALL UNDERGROUND UTILITIES A MINIMUM OF 3 BUSINESS DAYS PRIOR TO COMMENCING ANY CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY. CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY ALL LOCATIONS, DIMENSIONS AND ELEVATIONS OF ALL UTILITIES PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ADHERE TO ALL APPLICABLE TOWN OF OLD SAYBROOK STANDARDS AND REGULATIONS.
