- **5. Review of Bills** The commission reviewed bills dated 9/2/2020 through 9/25/2020 in the amount of \$24,565.45.

New Business

- A. Strategic Plan of Parks Francisco Gomes of FitzGerald & Halliday presented "Old Saybrook Parks and Recreation Strategic Plan." There was discussion on the need for adult baseball and softball fields. Commissioners discussed the strategic plan approach: equal investment among all parks or focus one/multiple parks at a time. Town Park priorities: playground, renovate pavilion/picnic areas, bathrooms, mountain bike trails, disc golf, better signage, move tree lines, remove basketball courts, add soccer and lacrosse fields & revise parking. Saybrook Point priorities: concession area/snack shack, bathrooms, Dock & Dine property incorporation, Gardiner's landing picnic area, river access, lighting by river walk, boardwalk/fishing pier, canoe/kayak launch & maximize parking lot. Main Street Park priorities: more pickleball courts, pool/splash pad, ice skating rink, dog park, band shell. Harvey's Beach priorities: bathhouse renovation, concert deck, playground, better entrance & attendant stand, wifi access, engineered beach & boardwalk.

7. Old Business

- **A.** All Parks Review Ray Allen stated mini golf is now closed, parks are busy and soccer season is ongoing. Irrigation, water and electric shut off at end of the month. All parks are green.
- **B. Preserve Update** Susan Esty reported damaged trees have been removed and the State is working on ATV usage and phantom bike trails. Invasive species have been cut back. Ray Allen reported Ingham Hill parking will start soon and work on the turnaround has begun.
