D. McCracken inquired about signage and Attorney Rosenthal confirmed it would be descrete.

Paula Kay inquired about hours of operation, it was confirmed by Attorney Rosenthal that hours would be normal business hours with very occasional 2nd and 3rd shift dependent on the season.

Kathleen Sugland questioned the noise level. Attorney Rosenthal confirmed small delivery trucks would be present, not large box trucks. Randomized routes and delivery/pick up times. Use of highway close by to limit traffic through town.
