- Michael advised of a spelling error on page 2.
- Paula had a question on EV charging.
- Page 3- Michael- last sentence is a bit bulky. Changes to be made.
- Page 4- No changes
- Page 5- Nick appreciated the definition of "complete streets". No changes.
- Page 6- Nick- item H- Suggest change "discourage" to "carefully consider".
- Nick questioned if the sidewalk plan was online. Chris confirmed that the sidewalk plan is from 2006.
 Hoping to have a revised map with completed and pending sidewalks. Also to include bikeways and
 complete street plans. Paula asked if there is a reason why there is not a sidewalk in front of the High
 School. Chris advised that there is grant funding to provide a sidewalk. Need to get info from DEEP to
 see what is allowed from Staples to Henny Penny bridge.
- Page 7- Nick under policy 4- zoning regs regarding EV chargers. EV regulations should not be in the same regulation as fueling station. New buildings should need to have charging stations.
- Chris added that we need to update the emergency response, public safety, personnel to handle electric issues, such as fires.
- Paula- change specifying hazards to Page 4, Policy 4F, to general emergency preparedness.
