

Regular Meeting November 27, 2023 MINUTES

A regular hybrid meeting of the Old Saybrook Police Commission was held on Monday, November 27, 2023. The meeting was recorded and can be viewed in its entirety at https://youtu.be/6ClbX czV0

Present: Chairman Wilcox, Vice Chairman Shippee, Secretary Notar-Francesco, Commissioners Prast, Von Dassel, Ciliano and Calle. Chief Spera was present from the Department of Police Services.

I. Call to Order / Pledge of Allegiance (0:21)

Chairman Wilcox called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM for the Police Commission and led those in attendance with the Pledge of Allegiance.

II. Adjournment to the Annual Town Meeting (0:46)

The Police Commission recessed to the Annual Town Meeting at 6:30 PM.

Following the Annual Town Meeting

The Police Commission resumed session at 7:12 PM.

III. Comments from the Public (1:20)

There were no comments from the public.

IV. <u>Expression of Gratitude for Departing Police Commissioners (1:28)</u>

Chairman Wilcox thanked both Commissioner Maselli and Manning for their work on the Police Commission.

Secretary Notar-Francesco stated that she learned a lot from Commissioner Maselli. She stated that she appreciated his efforts and his work on the by-laws.

Commissioner Von Dassel stated it was a pleasure working with both members.

Chief Spera thanked Commissioner Manning for her service. He stated that he valued her time and dedication to the Police Commission. He also thanked Commission Maselli stating that Commissioner Maselli was one of the original "SRO Dads" who led the charge of keeping the cops in the schools. He thanked both Commissioners on behalf of the Police Department.

V. <u>Welcome New Police Commissioners (4:09)</u>

Chairman Wilcox welcomed both new Commission members.

Secretary Notar-Francesco restated this welcome.

Commissioner Ciliano stated that he looks forward to working with everyone.

Commissioner Prast stated that it's nice that the members can all come together and work collaboratively.

VI. Election of Officers (5:50)

Commissioner Ciliano nominated Chairman Wilcox for Chair. Secretary Notar-Francesco seconded the motion. The motion passed with a vote of 7 in favor, 0 opposed and 0 abstaining.

Chairman Wilcox nominated Vice Chairman Shippee for Vice Chair. Commissioner Calle seconded the motion. The motion passed with a vote of 7 in favor, 0 opposed and 0 abstaining.

Commissioner Ciliano nominated Secretary Notar-Francesco for Secretary. Vice Chairman Shippee seconded the motion. The motion passed with a vote of 7 in favor, 0 opposed and 0 abstaining.

VII. <u>Discussion and Possible Action on the Meeting Minutes for:</u>

a. Regular Meeting - September 18, 2023 (8:17)

Secretary Notar-Francesco made a motion to accept the Regular Meeting Minutes for September 18, 2023. Vice Chairman Shippee seconded the motion.

Chairman Wilcox stated that on page 2 under the "2024 Executive Goals of the Chief of Police – Update," #1 has "competition" and it should be "completion."

The motion to accept the Regular Meeting Minutes for September 18, 2023 with the above change passed with a vote of 7 in favor, 0 opposed and 0 abstaining.

b. Special Meeting - October 18, 2023 (9:43)

Vice Chairman Shippee made a motion to accept the Regular Meeting Minutes for October 18, 2023. Secretary Notar-Francesco seconded the motion. The motion to accept the Special Meeting Minutes for October 18, 2023 passed with a vote of 6 in favor, 0 opposed and 1 abstaining (Von Dassel).

c. Special Meeting – October 30, 2023 (11:43)

Chairman Wilcox made a motion to add Special Meeting Minutes – October 30, 2023 to the agenda. Commissioner Ciliano seconded the motion. The motion to add Special Meeting Minutes – October 30, 2023 to the agenda passed with a vote of 7 in favor, 0 opposed and 0 abstaining.

Secretary Notar-Francesco made a motion to accept the Special Meeting Minutes for October 30, 2023. Commissioner Calle seconded the motion. The motion to accept the Special Meeting Minutes for October 30, 2023 passed with a vote of 6 in favor, 0 opposed and 1 abstaining (Von Dassel).

VIII. Discussion and Possible Action on the Regular Meeting Schedule for 2024. (12:22)

Commissioner Calle made a motion to accept the Regular Meeting Schedule for 2024 as follows. The 2024 Regular Meeting dates will be held Jan 22, Feb 26, March 25, April 22, May 20, June 24, July 22, August 26, September 23, October 28, November 25 and December 16 all starting at 6:30PM. Commissioner Prast seconded the motion. The motion passed with a vote of 7 in favor, 0 opposed and 0 abstaining.

IX. Executive Reports

a. Briefing on Noteworthy Operational Matters (19:42)

Chief Spera updated the Commission on Operational Matters.

Chief Spera advised the Commission that SRO Gabianelli has given her two-week notice. She has taken a job with a financial institution doing corporate security. She will be staying on as a per-diem patrolman.

Patrolman Tanner is able to help out 2-3 days a week at the high school and patrol will cover the remaining shifts.

Chief Spera stated that Patrolman Cruz has left the Department for the Middletown Police Department. Chief Spera described Patrolman Cruz as regrettable turnover. Chief Spera stated that Patrolman Cruz is still deciding if he wants to fill out an exit interview.

Chief Spera advised the Commission that after the budget meeting he will start rotating sergeants to attend Police Commission meetings. Chief Spera feels that it will be a great professional development experience.

Chief Spera stated that Captain DePerry formally retired at the end of October. Chief Spera has decided to keep him on as a per-diem employee.

Chief Spera stated that he is pleased to report on November 9th the Department was awarded Tier 2 Accreditation. He stated that this is two years ahead of state regulation. Chief Spera stated that one of his Executive Goals for next year is to achieve Tier 3 accreditation.

Chief Spera stated that six CT Law Enforcement agencies have achieved Tier 2 as of November 9th. Twenty-six have achieved national accreditation, so that means 125 agencies have not achieved what Old Saybrook has done. Chief Spera thanked Patrolman Milardo and Dispatcher Gosselin for their hard work.

Chief Spera stated that he is putting together his Executive Goals for next year which he will present during the budget season. He stated that there will not be as many goals as this year. He asked if any Commissioners had any thoughts or ideas for goals to please reach out to him.

Chief Spera advised the Commission that there was a FOIA hearing with New Haven Register regarding the Tyler Schulz internal affairs investigation. The hearing determined that the report needed to be handed out to the New Haven Register with specific names and addresses redacted.

Chief Spera passed around a thank you note from Mrs. Healey's Pre-K classroom.

X. <u>Discussion and Possible Action Concerning a New "Responsibilities of Commissioners" By-Law.</u> (37:39)

Secretary Notar-Francesco made a motion to adopt the recommended by-law. Commissioner Calle seconded the motion.

Secretary Notar-Francesco stated that there was total collaboration on this by-law. She thanked the Chief for his help on this, and Joe Maselli on helping move this along on many different aspects.

The motion to adopt the by-law passed with a vote of 6 in favor, 0 opposed and 1 abstaining (Prast).

XI. Correspondence (41:37)

XIII. <u>Discussion and Possible Action to Enter into Executive Session for the Purpose of Interviewing</u> Candidates for the Position of Patrolman to Fill Existing Vacancies. (42:08)

Secretary Notar-Francesco made a motion to enter into Executive Session for the purpose of interviewing candidates for the position of patrolman to fill existing vacancies inviting Chief Spera to join. Commissioner Ciliano seconded the motion. The motion to enter into Executive Session passed with a vote of 7 in favor, 0 opposed and 0 abstaining.

The Commission entered into Executive Session at 7:53 PM.

Kevin Leach entered into Executive Session at 8:10 PM.

Kevin Leach exited Executive Session at 8:21 PM.

The Commission exited Executive Session at 8:33 PM and resumed public session.

XIV. <u>Discussion and Possible Action to Appoint Individual(s) to the Position of Patrolman. (42:52)</u>

Commissioner Calle made a motion to extend an offer of employment to Officer Kevin Leach upon successfully completing the remainder of the hiring process and at a date that supports the operation of the Department to be determined by the Chief of Police. Commissioner Von Dassel seconded the motion. The motion passed with a vote of 7 in favor, 0 opposed and 0 abstaining.

A special hybrid meeting of the Old Saybrook Police Commission was held on Wednesday, January 10, 2024. The meeting was recorded and can be viewed in its entirety at https://youtu.be/sxiNF8a8qDk

Present: Chairman Wilcox, Secretary Notar-Francesco, Commissioners Calle, Von Dassel, Ciliano and Prast. Vice Chairman Shippee was present virtually. Chief Spera was present virtually from the Department of Police Services.

I. Call to Order / Pledge of Allegiance (0:20)

Chairman Wilcox called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM for the Police Commission and led those in attendance with the Pledge of Allegiance.

II. Comments from the Public (0:45)

There were no comments from the public.

III. Brief FY 25 Budget Overview By the Chief of Police (1:02)

Chief Spera presented a brief overview of the FY 25 Marine Patrol Budget.

Secretary Notar-Francesco asked about the discrepancy in the total budget numbers from last year.

Chief Spera stated that the Marine Patrol budget was reduced at the Board of Selectman/Board of Finance level but that the book uses the number that the Police Commission approved last year.

The Commission briefly discussed the Marine Patrol Budget.

Chief Spera presented an overview of the FY Operating Budget.

Chief Spera explained the budget philosophy and that the Police Officers are out of contract as of June 30, 2024. They will begin contract negotiations soon. The First Selectman and the Finance Director approved the 3% salary increase placeholder for FY 25 for the Police Officers, but Chief Spera explained that 3% could go up or it could go down.

Chief Spera discussed his proposed budget enhancement ideas with the Commission.

The Commission discussed pay equity for the position of Executive Assistant and creation of a Deputy Chief of Police position.

Chief Spera advised the Commission that he kept the General Expenditures flat except for an addition of \$5,000 to the Selection Process/Recruitment line item. This line item is related to the costs associated with the hiring process, medical costs, examinations, drug screenings, background checks and more.

Commissioner Calle asked about keeping the Building and Ground Maintenance line item flat. Chief Spera and the Commission discussed the police facility and a maintenance plan for the future.

IV. <u>Discussion and Possible Action on the FY 25 Marine Patrol Budget. (1:14:00)</u>

Commissioner Calle made a motion to approve the FY 25 Marine Patrol Budget in the amount of \$65,529. Commissioner Prast seconded the motion. The motion to approve the FY 25 Marine Patrol Budget passed with a vote of 7 in favor, 0 opposed and 0 abstaining.

V. <u>Discussion and Possible Action on the FY 25 Operating Budget. (1:15:22)</u>

Chief Spera asked if there were any documents or information that he should provide to the Commission for tomorrow's continued discussion.

The Commission discussed the budget enhancements to decide what is a "now" action in the proposed budget and what is something to think about.

The Commission will continue the discussion on the FY 25 Operation Budget tomorrow.

Old Saybrook Police Commission

Special Meeting January 11, 2024 MINUTES

A special hybrid meeting of the Old Saybrook Police Commission was held on Thursday, January 11, 2024. The meeting was recorded and can be viewed in its entirety at https://youtu.be/PPrVRUgc3XA

Present: Chairman Wilcox, Secretary Notar-Francesco, Commissioners Calle, Von Dassel, Ciliano and Prast. Vice Chairman Shippee was present virtually. Chief Spera was present virtually from the Department of Police Services.

I. Call to Order / Pledge of Allegiance (0:21)

Chairman Wilcox called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM for the Police Commission and led those in attendance with the Pledge of Allegiance.

II. Comments from the Public (0:44)

There were no comments from the Public.

III. <u>Discussion and Possible Action on the FY 25 Marine Patrol Budget. (1:05)</u>

There was no discussion or action on this item. The Commission voted and passed the FY 25 Marine Patrol Budget at the January 10, 2024 meeting.

IV. <u>Discussion and Possible Action on the FY 25 Operating Budget. (1:13)</u>

Chief Spera spoke to the Commission about a Deputy Chief position.

Chief Spera stated that \$46,925 would have to be added to the salary line item to properly compensate a "Second in Command" position. The \$46,925 is the delta between Patrolman #25's allocated salary and a second in command salary.

Chairman Wilcox agreed that the Commission needs to plan financially for a future Captain, Lieutenant or Deputy Chief. He stated that, even though there is nobody right now to fill that position, the Commission still should plan for it.

Secretary Notar-Francesco stated that she agrees with adding the additional money for that leadership position.

Chief Spera suggested calling the line item "Second in Command" for now.

The Commission discussed the pay equity for the Executive Assistant to the Chief of Police.

Chairman Wilcox stated that he initially supported the Chief's proposal, but then decided that he felt his suggestion wasn't the best way to approach pay equity for the Executive Assistant.

Chief Spera reviewed his proposal to the Police Commission. His proposal was to provide a stipend to the employee from the Outside Services account. The stipend would be non-pensionable and would not cost the town taxpayers any money.

Commissioner Ciliano asked what confidentiality things would bind the Executive Assistant position from being non-union.

Chief Spera explained the confidentiality within the Police Department and how the Town prefers to keep union members out of grievances and other personnel issues.

Chief Spera asked the Commission to endorse the theory as a possible solution to the pay equity request. He suggested to agenda the item to the January meeting to discuss the amount and specifics in Executive Session.

Secretary Notar-Francesco stated that she prefers more time to review this item.

Chief Spera reviewed his other budget enhancement positions.

Chairman Wilcox stated that he feels that he doesn't have enough information for the rest of the budget enhancements at this time.

Commissioner Calle made a motion to approve the FY 25 Operating Budget in the amount of \$5,593,526 with an additional \$46,925.00 added to Patrolman #25 making that a "Second in Command" position and to address the other budget enhancement ideas at a later date. Vice Chairman Shippee seconded the motion.

The motion was withdrawn.

Commissioner Calle made a motion to approve the budget as presented (\$5,593,526) with an additional \$46,925 added to the # 25 Patrolman for the position of Second in Command. Secretary Notar-Francesco seconded the motion.

Chief Spera advised the Commission that the final budget number will change as the salary addition will increase the FICA line item.

The motion to approve the budget as presented (\$5,593,526) with an additional \$46,925 added to the #25 Patrolman for the position of Second in Command passed with a vote of 6 in favor (Wilcox/Notar-Francesco/Shippee/Calle/Von Dassel/Ciliano), 1 opposed (Prast) and 0 abstaining.

V. Comments from the Public (51:35)

There were no comments from the Public.

VI. Comments from the Chief of Police (51:47)

The Chief of Police had no comment.

VII. Comments from Police Commissioners (51:58)

Commissioner Calle commented.

Secretary Notar-Francesco commented.

Secretary Notar-Francesco made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Calle seconded the motion. The motion to adjourn passed with a vote of 7 in favor, 0 opposed and 0 abstaining.
