Kicking off National Prevention Week (MAY 12-18) we will begin with Hidden in Plain Sight (HIPS) a substance awareness education program.

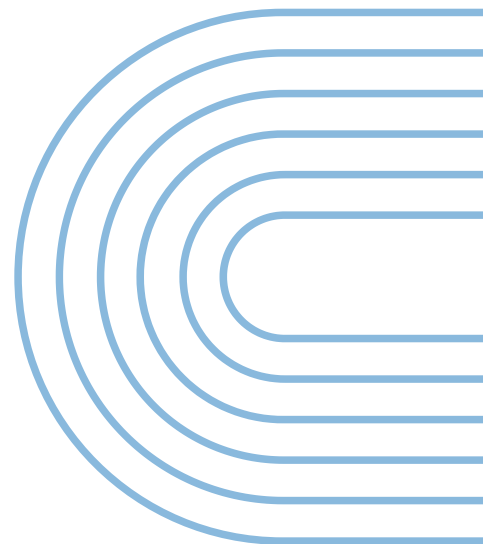

Hidden in Plain Sight is a presentation for adults to raise awareness of signs that may point to risky adolescent behaviors. This program recreates a mock teenagers bedroom that parents, grandparents, educators, caregivers and other adults can explore to identify hidden drug paraphernalia. We will discuss warning signs associated with youth substance use. As part of the program, trained staff guide attendees, explain various substance use trends, and identify signs and symptoms to watch for. Trained Staff provide guidance for initiating conversations with teens about substance abuse, and local resource information.



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
