COVID 19 Community UPDATE #40 – April 24, 2020

The following Community Update is being provided to you from the Town of Old Saybrook Emergency Operations Center.

The intent of this document is to provide a daily summary of preparedness, response and other government activities.

Public Safety & Community Information

- The Nation, State, and Town remain under Declared States of Emergency.
- The Town's Emergency Operations Center (EOC) remains operational.
- There were no new CONFIRMED cases of COVID-19 today in Old Saybrook.
- Old Saybrook belongs to the Connecticut River Area Health District (CRAHD).
- This includes the Towns of Chester, Clinton, Deep River, Haddam, and Old Saybrook.
- These are the current reported Positive Cases according to CRAHD: (No new cases today!)

Chester - 31 Confirmed Cases 6 Deaths
 Clinton - 30 Confirmed Cases 2 Deaths

Deep River - 9 Confirmed Cases
 Haddam - 18 Confirmed Cases
 Old Saybrook - 21 Confirmed Cases

- The weekend is upon us and tomorrow's weather looks nice! Go outside and enjoy the sun!
- Please make sure you adhere to Social Distancing Rules when going outside this weekend!
- No groups of more than five (5) people AND please maintain six (6) feet apart from others.
- PLEASE adhere to the Governor's Order and wear a mask in public!
- The Police Department will respond to complaints of those not following the rules.
- Do your part to prevent "community spread." Your actions affect the health of others.
- The Emergency Operations Center is working on a Face Mask for all Program for OS Citizens.

- The Public Safety Leadership Team met today with the First Selectman.
- We have seen a slight increase of crime. Unattended homes and vehicles should be locked.

- The District is working on plans for year-end grading and activities, by getting input from educators, parents, and students.
- The Superintendent and School Administrators are maintaining open communication with all students, parents, and staff.
