Public Safety

- The First Selectman has Declared a Local State of Emergency.
- The Town's Emergency Operation Center is operational.
- The Public Safety Leadership Team is meeting daily to coordinate preparedness and response activities.
- Public Fingerprinting and Probation Services are suspended.
- The Fire Department Facility is closed to the public. Member activities have been suspended.
- Police, Fire, and Emergency Medical Services stand at the ready to respond.
- The Emergency Operations Center is using Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, and Snapchat to connect with residents. Search COVID19OS to find us on your favorite social media platform.

Public Health

- DO NOT go out into the public if you have a fever or flu like systems.
- Practice social distancing. Maintain six (6) feet from other people.
- All Old Saybrook Fitness Centers are CLOSED.
- Restaurants and Bars that serve food are permitted to stay open for TAKE OUT ONLY.
