COVID 19 Community UPDATE #66 – June 3, 2020

The following Community Update is being provided to you from the

Town of Old Saybrook Emergency Operations Center.

The intent of this document is to provide a summary of preparedness, response and other government activities.

Public Safety & Community Information

- The Nation, State, and Town remain under Declared States of Emergency.
- The Town's Emergency Operations Center (EOC) remains operational.
- There were new CONFIRMED cases of COVID-19 in Old Saybrook since Monday.
- Old Saybrook belongs to the Connecticut River Area Health District (CRAHD).
- This includes the Towns of Chester, Clinton, Deep River, Haddam, and Old Saybrook.
- There were new CONFIRMED cases of COVID-19 in our Health District since Friday.
- These are the current reported Positive Cases according to CRAHD:
 - Chester 46 Confirmed Cases 10 Deaths
 - Clinton 60 Confirmed Cases 3 Deaths
 - Deep River 16 Confirmed Cases 2 Deaths
 - Haddam 36 Confirmed Cases 1 Death
 - Old Saybrook 35 Confirmed Cases 1 Death
- Our condolences to the Old Saybrook Family that lost a loved one to COVID-19.

In addition to Old Saybrook's residential cases listed above, Apple Rehab now has
52 COVID-19 Positive Patients. 19 staff members have also tested positive.

■ There have been fourteen (14) patients from Apple Rehab that succumbed to COVID-19. Our condolences to the families and staff members caring for them.

■ Old Saybrook Public Safety Leaders, Health District Leaders, and Apple Rehab Administrators held a conference call with State Department of Public Health Supervisors today.

- We expressed our detailed concerns and renewed our offer of assistance.
- Both Apple Rehab and State Officials are working closely to resolve matters.
- While hospitalization numbers are thankfully declining, Old Saybrook Public Safety Professionals are experiencing an increase in COVID-19 Related Medical Responses.
- COVID 19 is still here and we need your help not to create a Community Spread Issue!
- Wear a mask when in public to prevent Community Spread. We are counting on you!

- Still need face masks? Not able to make it last week? No problem!
- Simply stop by the Police Department, provide proof of residency, and get your masks!
