COVID 19 Community UPDATE #72 - June 25, 2020

The following Community Update is being provided to you from the Town of Old Saybrook Emergency Operations Center.

The intent of this document is to provide a summary of preparedness, response and other government activities.

Public Safety & Community Information

- The Nation, State, and Town remain under Declared States of Emergency.
- The Town's Emergency Operations Center (EOC) remains operational.
- There have no new CONFIRMED cases of COVID-19 in OS since our last report.
- Sadly a second Old Saybrook Resident succumbed to COVID 19. Our condolences.
- Old Saybrook belongs to the Connecticut River Area Health District (CRAHD).
- This includes the Towns of Chester, Clinton, Deep River, Haddam, and Old Saybrook.
- There were no new CONFIRMED cases of COVID-19 in our District since our last report.
- These are the current reported Positive Cases according to CRAHD:

- Chester - 46 Confirmed Cases 10 Deaths
- Clinton - 64 Confirmed Cases 4 Deaths
- Deep River - 17 Confirmed Cases 2 Deaths
- Haddam - 37 Confirmed Cases 1 Death
- Old Saybrook - 38 Confirmed Cases 2 Death

- One (1) previously reported Old Saybrook residential case has been deducted from the above list as it was found that the patient did not reside in Old Saybrook or our Health District.
- Old Saybrook has done a great job at preventing Community Spread Thank You!
- PLEASE do not lessen your efforts yet! Let's keep doing the things we are doing to save lives.
- We have learned much about how to protect ourselves & others from COVID-19.
- PLEASE wear a mask when in public to prevent Community Spread. IT WORKS!
- Still need face masks? No problem! We have them at the Police Department for you!
- The community transmission rate is now the lowest since the onset of the virus!
