COVID 19 Community UPDATE #74 – July 3, 2020

The following Community Update is being provided to you from the

Town of Old Saybrook Emergency Operations Center.

The intent of this document is to provide a summary of preparedness, response and other government activities.

Public Safety & Community Information

- The Nation, State, and Town remain under Declared States of Emergency.
- The Town's Emergency Operations Center (EOC) remains operational.
- There were two new CONFIRMED cases of COVID-19 in OS since our last report.
- Old Saybrook belongs to the Connecticut River Area Health District (CRAHD).
- This includes the Towns of Chester, Clinton, Deep River, Haddam, and Old Saybrook.
- There were new CONFIRMED cases of COVID-19 in our District since our last report.
- These are the current reported Positive Cases according to CRAHD:
 - Chester 46 Confirmed Cases 10 Deaths
 - Clinton 67 Confirmed Cases 4 Deaths
 - Deep River 18 Confirmed Cases 2 Deaths
 - Haddam 37 Confirmed Cases 1 Death
 - Old Saybrook 41 Confirmed Cases 2 Deaths
- We are a tad bit concerned......YES the State's Transmission Rate is LOW.....But...
- It is low because we are all doing our part by social distancing and wearing masks!
- We must continue our efforts to prevent community spread in Old Saybrook and CT!
- We know there will be gatherings this weekend and we want people to have fun..... BUT......

■ Let's keep doing the things we are doing to save lives – practice social distancing while at the backyard BBQ, wear a mask while playing that championship game of corn hole, wash your hands often and respect others who choose to protect themselves from contracting the virus.
