III. REGULAR BUSINESS

A. MINUTES

B. CORRESPONDENCE

IV. NEW BUSINESS

A. DISCUSSION: Food trucks as an accessory and subordinate use to Town events permitted under the Zoning Regulations. Jonathan Paradis, Assistant Director of Parks & Recreation

J. Paradis was not present.

R. Friedmann shared Madison, CT's "Rules Pertaining to Mobile Food Service Establishments and Mobile Food Vendors" effective 9/23/14 Revised by the BOS 9/22/14 with Commissioners. In Madison, food truck regulation is not a Zoning matter but rather a matter handled by the Board of Selectmen.

R. Friedmann suggested that whoever would like to have food trucks on Town property should know who is in charge of each Town property. Food trucks are event oriented, so they are normally used on weekends.

To regulate and enforce food trucks on weekends, the Zoning Enforcement Officer would need to be available for enforcement. This would impact town finances. There are many layers of this issue to consider.

B. WORKSHOP: Public Act 17-155 An Act Concerning Temporary Health Care Structures.

The Board of Selectmen voted for the Town to opt out entirely. The Zoning Commission would like Zoning Enforcement Officer Chris Costa to contact Town Attorney Mark Branse to get a legal opinion about how to opt out and what the proper time frame would be to do this in support of the Town.

The Commission would like to possibly have a public hearing in October on this matter.

C. Resolution for Incentive Housing Development Application

Action: Review resolution and consider adopting for purpose of Incentive Housing Development funding application to the State Department of Housing for Post & Main IHD, 7 North Main Street

The purpose of this resolution is to complete the application so the residential development at 7 North Main Street can be considered a completed Incentive Housing Development.
